

Rules & Regulations

We request your help in being good citizens as well as following the rules and regulations below.

1. All EARLY BIRD vendor registration & fees are due IN THE BACC OFFICE NO LATER THAN JUNE 23, 2017 AT 5PM. After June 23, 2017 a \$25 fee increase will be added and all vendor registration & fees will be due NO LATER THAN July 14, 2017.
2. Vendor fees may be paid by cash, money order, cashier's check, credit card or non-profit organization check. **No personal checks.**
3. Only cancellations received in writing via email to info@blackartskalamazoo.org by July 1, 2017 will receive refund, minus \$25 processing fee.
4. No display or sale of counterfeit or bootlegged merchandise.
5. Only two spaces allowed per vendor.
6. Vendors must supply their own tent, table and chairs. Tents must be anchored by sandbags or some other weighted items. Vendors are not allowed to drive stakes into the festival grounds.
7. If you have read the rules & regulations up to this point you will receive \$5 off your vendor fees. Email info@blackartskalamazoo.org to receive discount.
8. **Food vendors must comply with Health Department regulations. Call 269-373-5210 <http://kalcounty.com/eh/temporary-food.htm>**
9. Food vendors must not dispose of charcoal anywhere in the festival site.
10. Cooking grease must be appropriately contained for disposal at the festival site.
11. NO WATER OR POP SALES ALLOWED.
12. Vendors will be fined for any damage to park property including damage caused by the dumping of grease or other substances.
13. **No generators**, animals, weapons, contraband, profanity or loud amplified sounds. Vendors in need of electricity will need to bring at least a **50 foot commercial grade** extension cord.
14. **Set up begins at 7:30am. All vendors must be finished setting up, with vehicles removed from the Festival site by 10:00 am each day. Vendors must shutdown sales Saturday night by 8 pm and Sunday by 6pm. Vendors must be out of the park by 10:00 pm Saturday night and by 8:00 pm on Sunday. \$25 Penalty fee enforced**
